

**Agro advisory based on advices received from the experts of Agromet Advisory committee**

<b>Crop</b>	<b>Stage</b>	<b>Agromet Advisory</b>
Wheat, Barley	Booting	Keeping in view of rainfall/snowfall during last few days, farmers are advised to stop irrigation, fertilizer/chemical application for next few days as sufficient moisture is available in all the crops.
Sugarcane	Harvesting of previous crop, planting of new crop ratooning of old crop.	For taking ratoon crop, crop should be harvested after mid February and planting should be done when weather condition is suitable.
Onion, Garlic	Vegetative Growth	If the upper part of leaves of onion and garlic are turning yellow, solution of propiconazole or tebuconazole @ 1 ml/lit of water should be sprayed.
Potato	Harvesting	Potato should be dig out otherwise chances of infestation of fungal disease may be
Tomatoes, Capsicum, Brinjal and cucurbitaceous crops		To control the late blight disease in tomato, it is advised that solution of Mancozeb @ 2.5g/liter or copper oxichloride @ 3g/lit of water should be sprayed in clear weather condition.
Animal Husbandry	-	To save the animal from cold, increase the amount of oil and Jaggery (Gur) in the food of animals. Caraway (Ajwain) and gur also be given to the animals. To save the animal from cold, dry grasses, paddy residue (Puwal) etc which are not used as fodder for animals should be used as a bedding material for animals in sheds. Door and window should be covered properly so that cold wind could not be entered in the animal shed.
Poultry	-	Maintain the temperature of dwelling place of poultry birds. To save the poultry bird from cold, thickness of bedding material should be increases so that they can get sufficient heat to maintain their temperature.
