Weather Forecast of District NAINITAL (Uttarakhand) Issued On: 2024-04-12 (Valid Till 08:30 IST of the next 5 days)

Weather Summary/ Alert:

The upcoming days is expected to experience light to moderate rainfall of 1-10 mm with maximum-minimum temperature of 21-23oC and 9-11oC, respectively. The wind is expected to blow from southeast direction with a speed of 8-10 kmph. Light to moderate rainfall is likely to occur at many places from 13th to 16th April. Dry weather is likely to prevail during rest of the period. An orange alert regarding thunderstorm with lightening/hailstorm and gusty wind (40-50 kmph) is likely to occur at isolated places on 14th April, 2024 and yellow alert regarding similar occurrence with gusty wind (30-40 kmph) is likely to occur at isolated places on 13th and 15th April.

General Advisory:

A regular update regarding weather forecast and agrometeorological advisory is available on the "Meghdoot App" while "Damini App" is also available to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini apps can be downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Center (iOS users). The NDVI composite shows good agricultural vigour in the region. The extended range forecast system shows that the predicted trend from 12 April-18 April would observe large excess rainfall and below normal maximum-minimum temperature trend. Irrigation application and other farming operations should be scheduled as per the forecast and harvested produce should be stored well if left open in field.

SMS Advisory:

As per the forecast by India Meteorological Department, the farmers should schedule their farming activities accordingly and harvested produce should not be left in open.

Crop Specific Advisory:

Lentil/Field pea/ Yellow Mustard (Rada)		The mature pods should be harvested and the produce should not be left in open fields to avoid spoilage.

Wheat	Grain filling and harvesting	The irrigation and other field activities should be scheduled as per the forecast and harvested produce should not be left open in fields. The irrigation should be avoided at this stage to prevent lodging of crops.
Rice	Sowing	Sowing of Chetki Dhan should be delayed or scheduled as per the forecast.
