**Extension of Applications form submission date (till 27-11-2024) for Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) Internship Scheme at Northern Regional Laboratory, Mohali**

This is with reference to earlier notice no CBSH/MSCS/5054, Dated 13-11-2024 regarding the **Applications from students of GBPUAT for Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) Internship Scheme at Northern Regional Laboratory, Mohali.** In this regard, as per revised information obtained from BIS official, it is informed that:

1. Applications have been received from many students. However, the period of internship preferred by students is about 1 – 2 months and some students have preferred internship period from July 2025 - August 2025. **However, it is intimated that BIS, NRL, Mohali, seeks to engage students as Interns for about 5 – 6 months starting from January 2025 – June 2025.**
2. Further, it is intimated that as per the BIS Internship Scheme Degree/Diploma holders who have completed their studies within the last 180 days are also eligible for internship.
3. Accordingly, the **last date for receipt of applications for internships has been extended to 28 November 2024.** In view of above, interested students of **GBPUAT, Pantnagar are requested to apply for BIS-internship to join BIS, NRL, Mohali for about 5 – 6 months starting from January 2025 – June 2025.**

Please note that all the conditions mentioned in the earlier notice No CBSH/MSCS/5054, Dated 13-11-2024 remain the same.
