Weather Summary/Alert:

In the coming five days, very light rain may likely occur on 11 & 12 June otherwise weather will remain clear. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 28.0 to 29.0 deg C & 17.0 to 18.0 deg C respectively. Wind will blow with a speed of 8.0 km/hr from the ESE, SE, ENE & WSW direction. As per ERF, the rainfall, maximum & minimum temperature will be normal in the state from 15 to 21 June.

General Advisory:

NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.2-0.45 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate to good in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly dry conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks. Farmers are advised to download the "Meghdoot App" to get past week weather, weather forecast, and agromet advisory and "Damini App" to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini Apps can be downloaded from the google play store (Android users) and App Center (IOS users). To save the fruits from June drop, mulching should be used in the basins to conserve the moisture in the field.

	On the occurrence of fruit borer in the Tomato, fruit should be used only after 3 days and 5 days of spraying of Chlorantraniliprole 18.5 SC @ 150ml/Ha and Indoxacarb 14.5 SC @ 500ml/ha respectively.		
BRINJAL	To control the stem and fruit borer in brinjal, spraying of Emamectin benzoate 5SG @ 200g/Ha, Cypermethrin 25EC @200ml/Ha, Lambda cyhalothrin 5CS @ 300ml/Ha should be done and fruit should be used after 5 days of last spraying of chemicals.
