Weather Summary/Alert:

In the coming five days, moderate rain on 14 August and very light to light rain may occur on remaining days. Maximum & minimum temperature may range from 22.0 to 24.0 deg C & 15.0 to 16.0 deg C respectively. Wind will blow with a speed of 6.0 km/hr from the ESE & ENE direction. As per ERF, the rainfall, maximum and minimum temperature will be normal in the state from 17 to 23 August.

General Advisory:

NDVI & SPI map received from the India Meteorological Department dated indicated that the NDVI ranged between 0.1-0.35 for Nainital i.e. agriculture vigor is moderate in the district. SPI map indicates the mildly dry conditions in the district for the past 4 weeks (14 July to 10 August) Farmers are advised to download the "Meghdoot App" to get past week weather, weather forecast, and agromet advisory and "Damini App" to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini Apps can be downloaded from the google play store (Android users) and App Center (IOS users). Rain water should not be given to the animals and maintain proper drainage system in the field and spraying of chemical should not be done. In case of heavy rainfall, it is advised that proper drainage should be made from the basins of fruit plant.

SMS Advisory:

In the coming five days, moderate rain on 14 August and very light to light rain may occur on remaining days. Evergreen fruit plants like Mango, guava, Lemon, papaya, Litchi etc should be planted.

RICE	Top-dressing of urea @ 1.25 kg urea/naali after rain or when there is suitable moisture in the soil should be done in Chetki/Jethi paddy.
	Keeping in view the weather forecast and warning in coming days, farmers are advised, do not irrigate the maize crop and proper drainage should be maintained in the field.
SUGARCANE	Tie up of 5-6 sugarcane of each line should be done with the help of dry leaves up to 1.5-2.0 ft height from the ground.

BROCCOLI	Transplanting/sowing of radish, cabbage, broccoli and turnip should be done.			
VEGETABLE PEA	In unirrigated (rainfed) mid hilly regions, arrangement of the seeds of early variety of pea should be done for sowing them in the mid of August. Seed selected for sowing must be treated before sowing. In case of heavy rain sowing of seeds should be done after 15 August.			
	To control the white rotting in french bean, Caerbendazim 1 g/liter should be sprayed keeping in view the weather forecast.			
	To control the white rotting in cowpea (lobia), Caerbendazim 1 g/liter should be sprayed keeping in view the weather forecast.
