Weather Summary/Alert:

Last seven days (13 to 19 February) observed no rainfall with maximum and minimum temperature varying between 24.0-26.8 and 6.9-11.9 oC, respectively. The weather was observed to be clear on most of the days during last week. The morning and evening relative humidity varied between 84-94% and 26-50%, respectively. The wind speed mostly ranged between 1.4-3.4 kmph blowing primarily from the south, west, west-south-west, south-south-west and east direction. The upcoming 5 day forecast shows light rainfall of 5-10 mm from 20-22 February with maximum and minimum temperature varying between 23.0-25.0oC and 8-13oC. The wind speed is expected to be 8-9 kmph from west and south-west direction. There is a likely occurrence of light to moderate rainfall on 20 & 21st February at most places while very light to light rainfall is expected on 22nd February. Dry weather is likely to prevail during rest of the period. An orange and yellow alert warning has been given for occurrence of rainfall accompanied by thunderstorm, lightning/hailstorm/gusty winds with a speed of 30-40 km/h at isolated places as per predictions for 20 and 21st February, respectively.

General Advisory:

A regular update regarding weather forecast and agrometeorological advisory is available on the "Meghdoot App" while "Damini App" is also available to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini apps can be downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Center (iOS users). The NDVI composite shows moderate agricultural vigour in the region. The extended range forecast system shows normal rainfall and maximum-minimum temperature trend during 16 to 22 February. Rainfall has been predicted along with thunderstorm, lightning, hailstorm and gusty winds during 20-22 February thus farming operations can be scheduled accordingly.

SMS Advisory:

There is likely occurrence of rainfall accompanied with other weather aberrations during 20-22 February so the farming operations can be scheduled as per the forecast.
