Weather Summary/ Alert:

In the coming five days, light drizzle of 1 mm has been predicted for 22 October and dry conditions may prevail on the other days in the region. Maximum & minimum temperature may be 19.0-20.0 degree Celsius & 6.0-8.0 degree Celsius, respectively. Wind is expected to blow with a speed of 6-8 km/hr from the Southeast direction.

General Advisory:

The extended range forecast system for the region shows normal rainfall. The farmers are advised to download "Meghdoot App" to get last week's weather, weather forecast and agrometeorological advice and "Damini App" to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini apps can be downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Center (iOS users). This will help them in taking right decisions regarding farming activities.
