Weather Summary/Alert:

The weather will be clear in the next five days, and there will be light clouds with wind speed of 6.0-8.0 It is expected to move in the NE & ENE direction with a speed of km/h. The maximum and minimum temperature will be 19.0 to 25.0 and 7.0 to 10.0 degree Celsius respectively.

General Advisory:

Farmers are advised to download the "Meghdoot App" to get past week weather, weather forecast, and agromet advisory and "Damini App" to get lightning information. Meghdoot and Damini Apps can be downloaded from the google play store (Android users) and App Center (IOS users). In paddy-wheat cropping system, after harvesting wheat and other rabi crops, mainly sow dhaincha and sunai for green manure. Preference should be given to Sunai in sandy and loamy soils and dhaincha in heavy soil & waterlogged areas. The seed rate for dhaincha is 50-60 kg/ha and for sunai the seed rate is 80-90 kg/ha.

SMS Advisory:

The weather will be clear in the next five days, along with it will be partly cloudy. Wind with a speed of 6.0-8.0 km/h is likely to blow from NE & ENE.

| | In mid hills, sowing of varieties of barnyard millet (jhangora) like- Madeira 172, VL Madeira 207, PRJ 1 should be done 25 cm distance from line to line and 10 cm from plant to plant in April. 8-10 Kg/ ha seeds is required. N:P:K in the ratio 40:20:20 should be used. Half dose of Nitrogen and full dose of phosphorous and potash should be used at the time of sowing. Remaining half dose of nitrogen should be used after one month of sowing as top dressing. |
| MAIZE | In the plains, spring maize crop sown in mid-February, farmers should ensure the irrigation, weed control and spraying of urea in their fields, otherwise it will adversely affect the yield of maize. |
