#### **Forecast Summary:**

Last week (23 to 29 May) 23.4 mm rainfall was recorded with the maximum-minimum temperature ranging 31.5 to 35.5oC and 21.1 to 27.5oC, respectively. The morning and evening relative humidity ranged between 67-91% and 34-58%, respectively while the wind blew from east, east-north-east, south-east and east-south-east direction at a speed varying between 2.9-11.6 kmph. Most of the days were cloudy with hot and humid temperatures last week. The upcoming forecast shows light to moderate rainfall of 14-16 mm from 30 May to 3 June and maximum-minimum temperature are expected to vary as 35.0oC and between 23.0-25.0oC, respectively. The wind is expected to blow from south-east and south-south-east direction at a speed of 12-15 kmph. Yellow warning has been given regarding the occurrence of thunderstorms, lightning, squall, etc. and strong surface winds. Thunderstorm accompanied with lightning / gusty winds (40-50 kmph) likely to occur at isolated places between 30 May to 3 June.

#### Weather Warnings (Valid Till 08:30 IST of the next day)

Yellow warning regarding thunderstorms, lightning, squall, gusty winds (40-50 kmph) and strong surface winds has been given for isolated places.

#### Likely impacts of weather warnings on Agriculture and associated Agromet advisories

Impacts regular farming operations and ripened fruits ready for the harvest.

#### **General Advisory:**

The farmers and other related community can download the "Mausam" app for regular weather information and rainfall alerts. Other apps like "Meghdoot" and "Damini" are also available for regular updates of meteorological and lightning data, respectively. All the apps can be easily downloaded from Google Play Store (Android users) and App Centre (iOS users). The extended range forecast shows deficient rainfall and normal maximum-minimum temperature trend during 06.06.2025 to 12.06.2025.

## **SMS Advisory:**

Thunderstorm, lightning, strong winds have been predicted by IMD, so avoid irrigating the standing crops, harvest the ripened fruits, ready for sale.

### **Crop Specific Advisory:**

Crop (Stage)	Crop Specific Advisory
RICE (Nursery)	The transplanting nursery for rice can be prepared by wet or dry method. By wet method in irrigated areas nursery can be prepared 15-20 days before transplanting. In this water is added and all the weeds are allowed to germinate which are further puddled in the field itself. Dry method can be used in rainfed areas. Sowing can be done under light rainfall conditions.
SUNFLOWER (Maturity and Harvesting)	Avoid irrigating the crops and harvest the mature sunflower heads. The sunflower heads should be dried under covered place while in case of standing crops scaring away the birds is an important activity to prevent yield losses.
GREEN GRAM (Flowering)	Avoid irrigating under moderate rainfall occurrence. The weeding-hoeing operations should be rescheduled.
BLACK GRAM (Flowering)	Avoid irrigating under moderate rainfall occurrence. The weeding-hoeing operations should be rescheduled.
SUGARCANE (Vegetative)	The irrigation and hoeing-weeding operations should be delayed in the crop and postpone application of insecticide.
MAIZE (Physiological Maturity)	In case of mature cobs harvest them in time for sale. Avoid irrigating the crop.

## **Horticulture Specific Advisory:**

	Avoid irrigating the crop and regular farming operations should be rescheduled.		
	Mottled leaves if observed in the Pumpkin type vegetables, plant should be separated from others. The chemical spray should be postponed. Avoid irrigating the crop and use mulch to conserve moisture.		
	Destroy the plants with yellow veins and application of insecticide for sucking pests should be postponed. Avoid irrigating the crop and conserve moisture using mulch.

BUFFALO	With the advent of monsoon, humidity increases so continuous water supply should be maintained in the shed. Crop may fall, spoilage of ripened produce and other regular farming operations.

### Impact based advisories (General)

Avoid irrigating the crop, harvest the ripened produce, ready for sale and reschedule the regular farming operations.
