Schedule and important instructions for Online Proctored Entrance Examination of the aspirants of Masters', MCA and Ph.D. programmes

Online Proctored Entrance Examination from home will be conducted on 26.09.2020 for admission to all Masters' programmes and on 27.09.2020 for admission to MCA and all Ph.D. programmes. The candidates are advised to arrange a LAPTOP with inbuilt camera, 4 GB RAM, dual Core CPU and Google Chrome latest version installed on it. They are also advised to arrange proper net connectivity and an alternative network arrangement for any eventuality. In case, there is poor net connectivity in the area of their residence, they may appear in the examination from a neighbouring place where there is proper internet connectivity. This will be the responsibility of the candidates to ensure the abovesaid facilities for the said examination. They will put the camera on throughout the examination. They are also advised to avoid using any unfair means such as textbooks, notes, mobiles etc. during the examination, as every activity of the candidates will be recorded and will be taken care off. They will be issued a maximum of 5 warnings and after this, their answer sheet will automatically be submitted and no chance will be given to them to reopen the question paper. Due to any reason, if a candidate is found visible using unfair means after the examination at the time of checking the recording, his/her answer sheet will be blocked and a legal action will be taken by the university against him/her.

Admit cards for the said examination will be issued by 10.09.2020. the candidates are advised to see the university website regularly for further updates.
