The Prime Minister announced an allocation of over ₹42,000 crore for these schemes. Under this mission, central agencies will purchase 100% of the registered farmers' produce at minimum support prices, ensuring fair returns. The mission also aims to expand cultivation areas and improve productivity, marking a significant step toward self-reliance in pulse production.
