<u>Guidelines for the Award of "Bharat Ratna Pt. Govind Ballabh Pant Award" at</u> <u>Master's and Ph.D. level</u>

- 1. Screening of Theses would be first taken up at Departmental level and later at College level. (For screening the above criteria will be used and based on scores attained the best will be selected)
- 2. Any student having submitted his/her thesis during the year of award and preceding one year will be considered i.e., the thesis submitted between I & IInd Semester of Academic Year 2022-23 and 2023-24 would be eligible for the nominations.
- 3. Any student having won the award once shall not be considered for the same award in the following year.
- 4. The nominee should not be on AP/CP during his/her PG/Ph.D. degree programme in the University.
- 5. The Dean of the college would select two best (highest rankers) theses each for Master's and Ph.D. on the basis of marks scored.
- 6. The nominated students by the Dean of each faculty would make a presentation before the judging committee. The judgment would be based on innovativeness, concept, perspective, clarity, quality of research, conclusions and anticipated utility of the results to the Indian agriculture and allied sectors. The presentation would be rated for 50 Marks and 50 marks based on the above scores i.e., scores at faculty level will be considered.
- 7. An independent judging committee will be approved by the Vice Chancellor on the recommendations of Dean PGS.
- 8. Bharat Ratna Pt. Govind Ballabh Pant Award for Masters' and Ph.D. shall be awarded to one Masters and one Ph.D. student at the University level. The highest scorer at College level would be awarded an appreciation certificate for the good work done by him/her.
- 9. The nominated students will be paid 3 A/C train fare for attending presentation on production of receipt, which will be met by the concerned Colleges from where they were nominated.
- 10. The Award will be distributed during the University foundation week.
