PANTNAGAR UNIVERSITY

Name of the presenting author should be underlined. Only quality papers will be accepted in the relevant technical sessions for publication. Not more than one lead paper and one abstract of a particular participant will be accepted. Submitted abstracts/Lead Paper will be evaluated by a scientific committee and decision regarding acceptance/rejection will be communicated to the corresponding authors. One compendium comprising of all accepted abstracts and **one separate book with ISBN number** will be published and will be made available along with certificate to all the registered delegates by post.
